## **Someone will win a \$15,000 bond at NES Nationals!!**

**NES has gone back to basics, back to a hobby that everyone can enjoy. Back to a pageant where you don't need to spend a fortune to keep up with the Jones'. Back to a pageant where everyone has an equal chance regardless of whether you had a top designer make your dress or you bought it at Sears. Back to a pageant where the cost of H/M doesn't exceed the entry fee, which has kept many from competing. How has NES changed to do this?**

1. There is no attire score at all. We have decided any attire is acceptable however, we prefer flower girl type dress, Sunday Best, Prom Style or Cocktail Dresses. We do not want people to go out and have to buy or have new clothes made to compete, so anything is acceptable. Should you wear a fully glitz dress, you will have no advantage over someone who wears a flower girl dress as there is no attire score at all. Beauty will be based on facial beauty, poise and smile/eye contact. AGAIN - There will be NO ATTIRE SCORE at all

2. Professional H/M will not be required or needed, but it will be allowed, the criteria for judges will be no big hair, no falls, no wiglets and no hairpieces will be allowed. Hair must be natural looking, but nice and dressy. No fake eyelashes and no flippers. Everyone can do this type of H/M and there is no advantage to getting it done professionally. If someone wants to have it done professional, there is no problem with that, but you can definitely do that type of H/M yourself just as easily. Any hairstyles that are not natural looking or makeup that is not natural looking/age appropriate will have points deducted. Under 10, should stick with minimal makeup like lip gloss, blush to keep them from fading out under the bright stage lights, no dark lipsticks or heavy eye shadow. Makeup in the older divisions should be nothing more than you would wear to school or work.

3. There are no events for Proam. We will have a Casual/Runway event and a swim/fitness event, which should all be runway style.

4. There is no glitz/pageant photogenic category. We are only offering Natural Photogenic (meaning no touchups unless it's a stray hair or something like that). The judges will be looking for photos that look like photos (meaning not perfect skin, not perfect in every way, something that looks like a real person and age appropriate). The judges do not want photos in the 5 yr division that look like a 15 yr old. The cost of touchups is out of control and actually changing many photos to the degree, the child is sometimes unrecognizable. This is NOT what we want. We want a nice photo of the contestant, so the contestant and their photogenic qualities are being judged, not the photographer. Any size photo can be entered and they will be returned following awards.

### **RULES/REGULATIONS**

1. All judges' decisions are FINAL!
2. Good sportsmanship is required at all times. Failure to show good sportsmanship (including parents & guests) will result in disqualification of the contestant without a refund and forfeiture of any awards received.
3. Do NOT call and ask WHO will be competing, we will NOT tell you.
4. Entry fees are non refundable if you pull out. If something were to happen that the pageant got cancelled a full refund will be given.
5. Entrant gives the NES pageant director(s) the right to use her name and photo for publicity purposes.
6. The directors have the right to refuse entry of any contestant or admission to the ballroom of any parent/guest, as this is a private function.
7. The director/staff may request proof of date of birth at any time, please come to the pageant with a copy of the contestant's birth certificate.
8. By signing the application you affirm that all information is true and correct, including date of birth and that you have read and understand all the rules/guidelines. You also understand that the pageant or anyone connected with this pageant including the hotel is not responsible for loss or injury incurred at or in travel to and from the pageant.
